

Remarks from the Executive Director

- 2024 was a year of C5 operating on faith as the percentage of clients presenting with incomes at or below \$35,000 increased to 209, or 71% of our agency. This is the highest number and percentage of low-income clients C5 has served across the 22-year history of the agency. Funding did not extend to this number of low-income clients, and the Board approved using our agency Reserve funding to meet this need. Fundraising efforts were also increased to maximize the impact on agency reserves.
- Private donors and Supporting Churches made the ministry to C5 possible this year. The Board of Directors and staff are grateful to the faithful donors and supporters!
- C5 has continued to take clients through insurance with one fully licensed Clinician. The goal for 2025 is to increase the number of Clinicians licensed and able to serve clients through insurance. This will support the bottom line and allow C5 to provide services to more clients who are low income.
- In 2024 C5 served 294 clients with 2337 active hours of service provided. Thank –you for your on-going support!


C5 Funding Sources 2024 Actual Income: \$215,234
